

To the Regents of the University of the State of New York:

WE, the undersigned, all being persons of full age, and at least two-thirds of our number being citizens of the United States and one a resident of the State of New York, desiring to form a corporation under the Education Law, do hereby apply to the Regents of The University of the State of New York for a provisional charter to be granted pursuant to the provisions of Section 216 of such law, and do make, sign and acknowledge the following statement:

FIRST: The name of the proposed corporation is WESTCHESTER ACADEMY OF RESTORATIVE DENTISTRY.

SECOND: The purposes for which such corporation is to be formed are: To promote greater post-graduate education and study in the field of Restorative Dentistry; to evaluate through group study new concepts and discoveries in Restorative Dentistry and to conduct clinical research on a controlled plane in the field of Restorative Dentistry; to help advance the level of Restorative Dentistry for the betterment of human kind and particularly to help advance the level of Restorative Dentistry in the Westchester area; to contact and bring to Westchester nationally known lecturers in Restorative Dentistry; to provide more advanced discussions and material on Restorative Dentistry; and to conduct diagnostic evaluation in group study of the more difficult problems in Restorative Dentistry for the future advancement of a more scientific approach to Restorative Dentistry.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we have made, signed, and

THIRD: The proposed corporation is to be a non-stock corporation organized and operated exclusively for educational purposes, and no part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any individual; and no officer, member, or employee of the corporation shall receive or be entitled to receive any pecuniary profit from the operations thereof, except reasonable compensation for services.

FOURTH: The institution to be maintained by the proposed corporation is located at the Harwood Building, Suite 322, Scarsdale, New York.

FIFTH: The number of trustees is to be five. The Board of Trustees shall have power by vote of two-thirds of the members of said Board to change the number of trustees to be not more than twenty-five nor less than five.

SEVENTH: The Commissioner of Education is designated as the representative of the corporation upon whom process in any action or proceeding against it may be served.
